

# DATA FOR **PROGRESS**

From July 22 to 29, 2022, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 631 likely voters in Arizona using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is  $\pm 4$  percentage points.
